

## Jude

Read through the book of Jude in your Bible, and as you do, shade the author in blue pencil and those he was writing to with orange pencil. Also shade the corresponding pronouns for each the author and recipients.

Read through Jude again and now circle “certain persons” and “ungodly persons” in red pencil.

Read verses 5-7

Read verses 8-9

Reading from verse 17-23, note the five instructions that Jude gives as a defence against false teachers.

Mark each instruction with (1i, 2i, 3i, etc) in the margin of your Bible to spot them easily. [Lower case “i” means instruction]

1. Who is the letter from?
2. Who is the letter to?
3. Who are these men? What are they like?
4. What did Jude remind his audience of in verses 5-7?
5. How did the archangel, Michael deal with satan?
6. Briefly summarize Jude’s instructions.

## Interpret

How should the believer respond when faced with false doctrine?

## Apply

What do you need to do when you hear false teaching from the pulpit or conference speaker? Would you need Scriptural references to back up your claim? What about book authors? Would you treat them the same?
